A major storm system moved from the Southern Plains into Indiana Thursday bringing rain mixed with sleet, freezing rain, and snow to Northern Illinois. It was mostly rain, sleet, and freezing rain south of I-88 with more snow in the Northern Counties near the Wisconsin state line. There was a lull in the precipitation during the afternoon, then light snow spread back across the entire region late in the day and evening as colder air pushed into the region. With temperatures falling into the 20s there was major freezeback after dark. Most of the snow had ended by daybreak, except in Northwest Indiana where Lake Effect snow set in early Friday morning. Snow amounts from the Lake Effect will be covered in the report for 2/17/23. Temperatures were in the 30s during the day Thursday, then fell into the 20s overnight. Winds caused minor to moderate blowing and drifting of the snow Thursday night.
